

SAXL ROSE BIO

Antonio Hancock, professionally known as Saxl Rose, is an American musician, multi-instrumentalist, recording artist, and producer.

By the time Saxl began studying traditional music in elementary school, he already had years of experience performing. He continued studying music performance throughout high school & college, even completing a saxophone program at Berklee College of Music.

Shortly after this, Saxl became involved in a string of musical projects, including his own rock/metal outfit “Listen For The Light” and Maryland Pop-punk band Chasing Morgan. During this time, he was featured on the FUSE network television show “Warped Roadies” covering his hometown performance on the tour.

Over this past year, Saxl's career has taken off. His saxophone covers of popular songs are quickly becoming a hit on social media, even grabbing the attention from the likes of Wiz Khalifa, Hayley Williams of Paramore, All My Children Star Chrishell Hartley, and many more. His most popular cover of Paramore’s “Ain’t It Fun” reached over a quarter million views in less than a day. Soon after, Paramore brought out Saxl Rose to perform “Ain't It Fun" live as a part of their After Laughter album tour.

Soon after, he joined UK Pop-punk band on select dates of their US tour for their “The Peace & The Panic” album tour. Performing a string of sold-out venues such as PlayStation Theatre in New York City, Rams Head Live in Baltimore, and Henry Fonda Theatre in Los Angeles. Saxl was also featured on NBC’s “Last Call with Carson Daly” in April of 2018.

Since then, Saxl has been collaborating with a stream of popular artists and performing with bands such as State Champs, Issues, Stand Atlantic, Real Friends, and more. He has also performed on 2018's final Vans Warped Tour as a solo artist, as well as 2019's 2-day Warped Festival in Atlantic City with Neck Deep.

R&B/Hip-Hop artist Chris Brown also recently shared his saxophone cover of "No Guidance" on his Instagram, which currently sits just under a million views. Saxl Rose is currently recording his solo debut, which will feature all original work and notable guest features.
